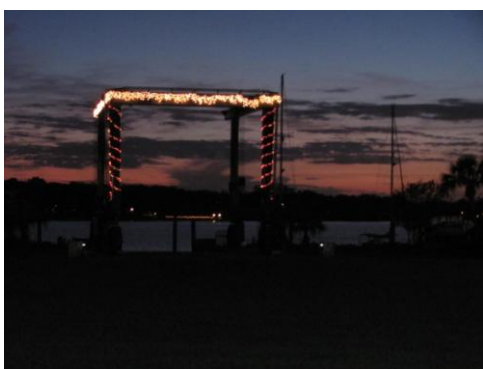


Happy Holidays
