Bayou Improvements

Our local area had been experiencing low amounts of rainfall, almost drought-like conditions, but all that has changed over the last couple of weeks due to a large amount of rainy weather.

In the past this formula would lead to a very murky Bayou Chico and Health Alerts from the Health Department, but that has not been the case. In our last newsletter we discussed the Bayou Chico Basin Management Action Plan or BMAP. It appears this BMAP, local business, and Escambia county projects are making a positive impact on the Bayou's water quality.

It has been some time since any warnings have been issued for Bayou Chico, although our other area waterways have not been so lucky. Some of the improvements we can see, like the dredging and replacing of sheet pile on the W Street run-off basin, but there are others that we cannot, like ECUA coating the existing underground sewer lines.

All of these projects have made an impact and we can only hope for the continued improvement to the Bayou. Here is a link with a listing of some of the projects.


